With the community, we've built an innovative, comprehensive center that is transforming treatment for cancer patients and their families. The Sentara Brock Cancer Center is a \$93.5 million, 253,000-square-foot home unifying care and recovery.

Cancer is not only a devastating disease; it's a daily disruptor. The Sentara Brock Cancer Center is a one-stop home for healing, delivered by a collaborative team of caregivers. No longer do

patients struggle to travel from one appointment to another throughout the region for key services.

Here, patients and their families will benefit from the most recent advancements in treatment. Here, they will find everything from radiation oncology to wellness classes to support groups.

By bringing together multiple specialists across disciplines, our Cancer Center can provide personalized, advanced treatment and create a new paradigm for cancer care in our community.

COMMUNITY IMPACT

A Critical Need

The number of Americans diagnosed with cancer is expected to increase over 36 percent by 2030. By then, more than 22 million Americans will be cancer survivors with diverse, ongoing needs. In Virginia, cancer has leaped past heart disease as the leading cause of death.

More than 45,000 Virginians were diagnosed with cancer in 2019. Throughout Hampton Roads, diagnoses of breast cancer, colorectal cancer, lung cancer, and prostate cancer are significantly higher than the state average.

Every year, more than 10,000 people in our community hear the words, "You have cancer." We need to change the stories behind those numbers.

Dramatic breakthroughs in treatment and early detection have increased the survival rates for all cancers by more than 25 percent in the last two decades. That means more time with loved ones, but also a journey with continuing challenges.

Living beyond cancer means adjusting to a new normal, physically and emotionally. What's next? Together at our Cancer Center, we are developing the right answers for every individual.

COMMUNITY OUTREACH TO SAVE LIVES

Early detection saves lives. Some of the most regularly diagnosed cancers, like breast, cervical, and skin cancers, are also some of the most preventable. Screening can prevent cancer by finding and treating lesions before they become cancerous or by detecting cancers at an early stage when treatment is most effective. More than 90 percent of patients diagnosed with breast, colorectal, and ovarian cancer survive at least five years if cancer is detected early.

Working together with community partners, our Cancer Center is expanding our outreach and education efforts. We are:

- Expanding access to early detection, prevention, and education programs
- Partnering with community organizations to increase access to services
- Targeting underserved communities by creating new programs and services





Timely, Compassionate Care

When Clayres Johnson was diagnosed with breast cancer, she had no idea what a marathon it would become. Suddenly, she had not one doctor, but three — a surgeon, a medical oncologist, and a radiation oncologist. Over the course of her year in treatment, she made nearly 70 trips to offices in Norfolk, Suffolk, and Virginia Beach while caring for a 14-year-old, a two-year-

old, and a one-year-old. She experienced firsthand the stress of a diagnosis followed by an exhausting schedule traveling to treatments and office visits.

As an oncology nurse navigator at Sentara, she pairs with women from the time they're diagnosed with breast cancer until their treatment ends.

"It can just be overwhelming. Having everything in the same place is so incredible, such an opportunity for our patients. It's an anchor for them, one less stress. The Cancer Center is an incredible endeavor. I'm super excited to be a part of it."


The Power of our

- Survivorship center






